Announcing the second Adult Skater Theatre on Ice Performance and Workshop to be held Friday July 1 – Sunday July 3, at Great Plains Arena in Calgary. A 3 day workshop where skaters of all levels can improve performance skills under the guidance of experienced show skaters, coaches, and choreographers. We are extremely honored to have Carlotta Edwards, of Dancing on Ice and Battle of the Blades FAME, as a performer and performance mentor for the cast.

The theme and title for this year is "Fame & Fortune". Adult skaters are invited to participate through a solo program (max 2:10), if they would like to perform solo and receive personalized performance feedback as well as feedback on all performance throughout the weekend. Adult skaters may opt to only participate in the workshops and group numbers and receive performance coaching throughout the weekend.

The music and choreography for the solo's are the skater's choice (bonus points for matching the theme but not necessary) Hints and suggestions for solo music can be found on the registration page, along with music already spoken for.

The weekend workshop will begin on Friday afternoon and end on Sunday afternoon with our 2 hour performance that is created over the weekend. Skaters will participate in performance workshops, choreography of group numbers and fun transitions between each number. There will be 2 full dress rehersals of the show throughout the weekend before the actual performance. Meals will be provided on site for the working dinner on Friday and breakfasts on Saturday and Sunday. Soup will be available for afternoon snacks on Saturday and Sunday. A draft schedule is attached.

Costumes for the show are at the discretion of the skaters but must be basic black in nature. Black tights/leggings and tops will be needed for the group numbers. Props are encouraged and should be the theme color gold/golden, as this is the color of the show for this year. If you have never worked with a prop, this is your opportunity to learn.

A silent auction will be held at intermission to help raise funds to support this initiative. Silent auction items and sponsors are welcome please! Each participant is encouraged to invite your friends and family as a good audience makes a good show.
